I will be learning...

<u>ENGLISH</u>

This term, we will be reading **The Dragon Machine** by Helen Ward.

We will continue to develop our stamina when writing and the mastery keys we focused on before Christmas. Also in our writing we will now be introducing the use of suffixes at the end of words eg) -ed, -ing, -er, -est.

When punctuating sentences we will be developing the use of question marks and exclamation marks.

Following this we will begin an environmental focus and read 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley'.

<u>MATHS</u>

In our maths lessons, we will be learning about measure,

numbers to 40, addition and subtraction word problems, multiplication, division and fractions. We will then be focusing on numbers to 100. We will continue to practice our fluency and mental methods in the afternoons during arithmetic.

<u>PSHE</u>

This half term for PSHE, everyone in school will be concentrating on 'Dreams and Goals' and what makes us special.

<u>SCIENCE</u>

We will develop our understanding of everyday materials by being able to distinguish between object and material. We will identify and name everyday materials and we will describe, compare and group everyday materials based on physical properties. We will identify, name and describe common wild and garden plants as well as identify the parts and structure of a plant. We look forward to visiting 'Imagine That' in February.

HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY

We are looking forward to comparing toys through time. We will begin with the Victorian era and continue chronologically until 2023. In Spring 2, we will learn about the Geography of the UK and the capital cities.

<u>ART & D.T.</u>

In Art will investigate artwork by Henry Moore, before recreating his work, using the wax resist technique.

We are looking forward to having a full day of DT later in the term.

PE will be on <u>Fridays</u> and we will be covering dance and athletics. Please ensure your child has a full, school PE kit. PE takes place outside when weather permits.


