## ENGLISH

In English, we will be covering a wide variety of texts including 'Of Thee I Sing' which is the text written by Barack Obama to his daughters about inspirational figures. We will be focusing on using brackets in our writing as well as using a wide range of vocabulary and cohesive devices.

## MATHS

We are very excited to have started Maths No Problem this year which is a scheme where the children will receive their own personal workbooks. These will challenge the children on their maths learning journey. To start, we will focus on our attention on place value and the four operations.



## PSHE/RE

## Things you will need in Year 6...

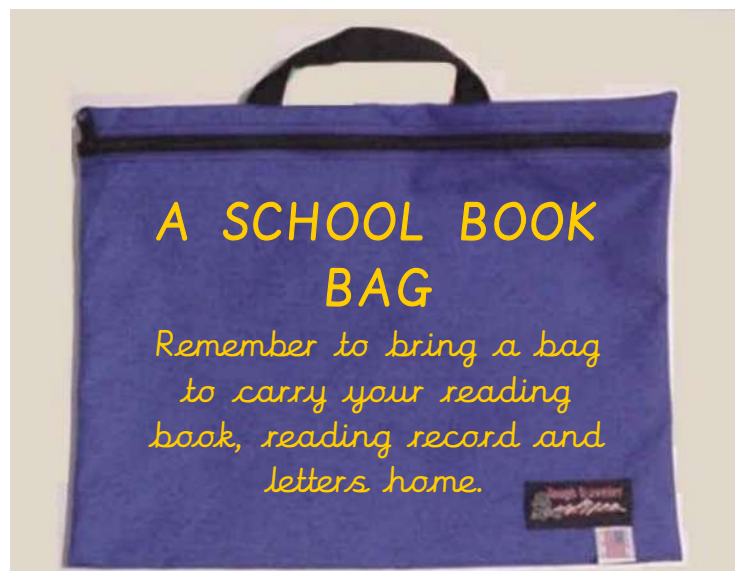


### SCHOOL SHOES
