I will be learning...

ENGLISH

MATHS

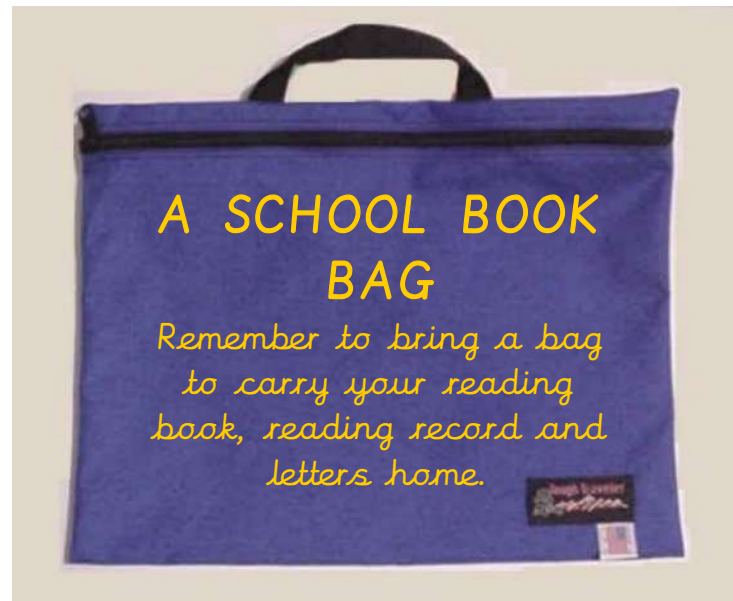


SCHOOL SHOES
