Welcome to our newsletter.

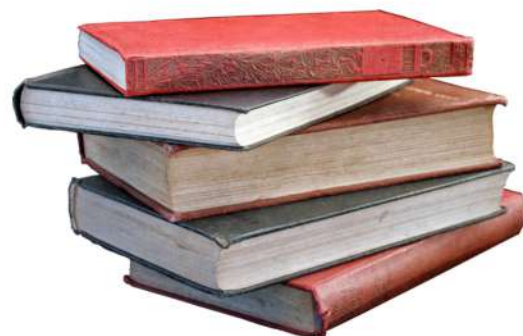
We have had a brilliant week in school. Children have worked so hard this week and I have seen many examples of motivated and independent learners.
