

I call my aunt to see how she is doing Keeping the ties of kinship is something I am pursing




I feed those in need It reminds me of the Hadith of feeding those who are fasting They get a big reward indeed




I pray my salah on time Making sure to do my sunnah and athkar to get rewarded by The Sublime
