I will be learning...

#### <u>ENGLISH</u>

This term, we will be reading Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. This text will be followed by further fictional texts and poetry. We will be writing letters, diaries, stories and nonchronological reports.

In Year 1 we will be developing our independence and stamina when writing, using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops to improve our sentence writing.

In Year 2 we will continue to develop our stamina when writing and use conjunctions to improve our sentences.

#### <u>MATHS</u>



In Maths lessons, Year 1 will be

learning about place value, number bonds and focusing on addition and subtraction within 10. Year 2 will still be focusing on place value but will look at numbers up to 100. We will focus on consolidating previous learning and using our counting fluently during daily arithmetic.

#### <u>PSHE</u>

This half term for PSHE, everyone in school will be concentrating on 'Being Me.' In term 2 we will be 'Celebrating Difference.'

#### <u>SCIENCE</u>



During Science this term, will develop our understanding of living things and their habitats. We will compare habitats and microhabitats, and spend time at the allotment observing animals in their microhabitats. We will then move onto food chains before creating our own.

#### HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY

We are looking forward to learning more about our family, making family trees and studying the royal family tree of King Charles III.

In Geography, we will learn all about the seven continents and the five oceans.

#### <u>ART/D.T.</u>

In Art will investigate artwork by Jan Poynter, before creating our own interpretation of her work.
