V E V E day by India



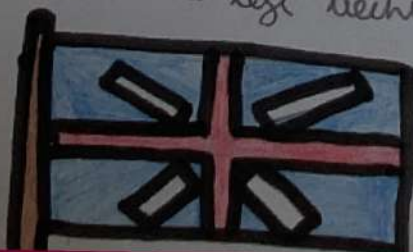
When the war came,
