Attendance and Punctuality

We are pleased to see improvements in our school attendance. Our whole-school target is 97%, which equates to approximately six days missed across the academic year.

If a child's attendance falls below 90%, this means they have missed around 19 days of school over the year.

We understand there are exceptional circumstances when children are unable to attend school, and we are committed to supporting families when this arises. However, arriving late and missing the morning register means lost learning time and can have a detrimental impact on overall attendance.

From a safeguarding perspective, if your child is unable to attend school, please ensure you contact the school office.

We do request medical evidence to authorise absences, particularly where attendance is a concern.

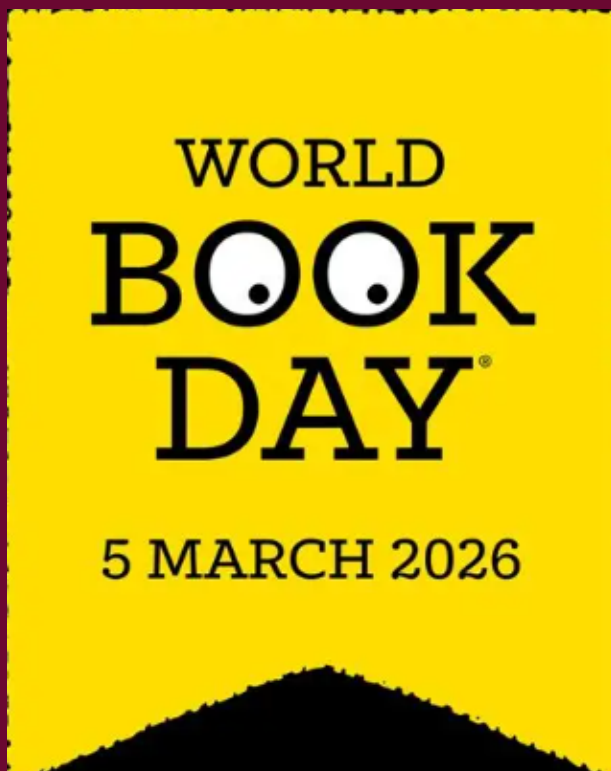

We break up for the Easter holidays on Wednesday 1st April 2026.



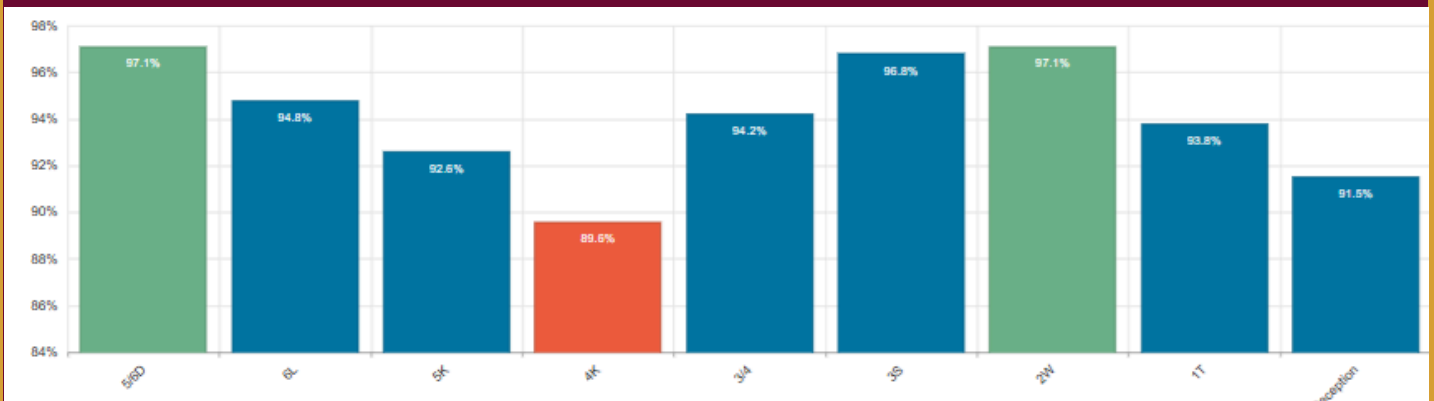
